# Anesthetic/ Procedure Consent Form

At our Hospital we strive for excellence when caring for your pet. When anesthetic procedures are required, we recommend minimizing the risk by using blood tests, IV catheters, and fluids. We also recognize that there are times and situations when you may prefer less costly options. We respect this and ask that you help us meet your expectations by filling out the following.

### Pre-Anesthetic Blood work

Blood tests are used to screen for medical problems that may not be apparent on physical examination and could increase anesthetic risk. More involved tests provide more information but incur greater costs. We encourage some level of blood screening be done for all animals undergoing an anesthetic. **We recommend option 1 or 2 for senior animals and a minimum option 3 for younger animals.**

### Pre-Placed Catheter with Intravenous (I.V.) Fluids

A pre-placed I.V. catheter provides access for administration of medication if indicated during anesthesia. Continuous I.V. fluids during anesthesia help to maintain your pet's blood pressure. This is important for providing adequate blood flow to their vital organs such as the liver and kidneys. **Because of the significant benefits of I.V. fluids, we recommend them for all anesthetic procedures, especially dog spays, involved soft tissue surgery, lengthy procedures and for all animals older than 5 years.**

### Laser Surgery

For your pet's comfort and enhanced recovery from surgery we are pleased to offer the option of laser surgery technology. Pets undergoing laser surgery will generally have less bleeding and swelling at the surgical site and potentially less discomfort. The laser option fees vary depending on the surgical procedure and range from and **additional fee of \$68.43 - \$136.76**
